After Care Instructions For Your Pet

Food and Water - Only small amounts of water and food should be offered to your pet when you get home. Some vomiting could occur because of anesthesia.

Exercise and Activity - Animals that are recovering from illness or surgery should have limited exercise. Leash walking only **OR** absolute cage rest.

Medication - Follow all medication instructions and finish meds.

Follow Up -

_____ Suture removal in 14 days-No licking at incision site.

_____ Drain Removal in _____ days- No licking, expect drainage from site.

_____ Post medical / surgical recheck in _____ days

_____ Bandage / Splint removal in _____ days- **Keep dry at all times!**

_____ E-Collar must be worn at all times to prevent licking
or chewing at incision site.

A decrease in activity or appetite for one to two days may be observed. However, if your pet exhibits any of the following symptoms please notify us.

- Loss of appetite for over 2 days
- Refusal to drink water for over 1 day
- Depression
- Vomiting or Diarrhea or any discomfort or pain
